



“I don't know whether I'm qualified”



On one Friday evening...

an enthusiastic group of 39 students packed the classroom, excited for another class led by Moses on “Building Legacies and Movements” (it is a class our Masters students are taught about discipleship and passing it on). The students were excited when he encouraged them to share their feedback based on what they had been learning. Just then, *Adam, one of the students, spoke up, igniting a spark of discussion that set the tone for a new spiritual journey for him.

He said, “If I am asked to say where I am regarding my faith, I am like the young man who Jesus told, sell everything and follow me. So, like that young man...I don't know whether I'm qualified to be a disciple of Jesus. Consideration should be given to people like me, who need discipleship.” (The class was required to start their own discipleship groups).

Little did we know that the Lord had been working in Adam's heart. His curiosity about becoming a disciple of Christ sparked a glimmer of hope in our hearts. Recognizing this opportunity, Moses invited Adam for a cup of tea the following week, hoping to guide him in discovering what it truly means to follow Jesus.

Early on Monday, Adam was already seated at the coffee shop with an air of anticipation. Moses had asked another Christian student named *Kiota to accompany him, recognizing the importance of this moment (both to model witnessing and for context in the Kenyan setting). The conversation that unfolded over the next two hours was rich with questions and philosophical musings.

Adam's desire to understand the Christian faith was unmistakable, and we could see the wheels turning in his mind. Adam committed his life to Christ for the first time.

We arranged to meet Adam weekly for Bible studies. We believe God will nurture his newfound faith and equip him to make a difference in the lives of others.



We felt a profound hope as we watched Adam begin this incredible chapter of his life, trusting that God would use him powerfully in the community. Even though Adam didn't believe he was qualified, God chooses, qualifies, and equips those He calls.
