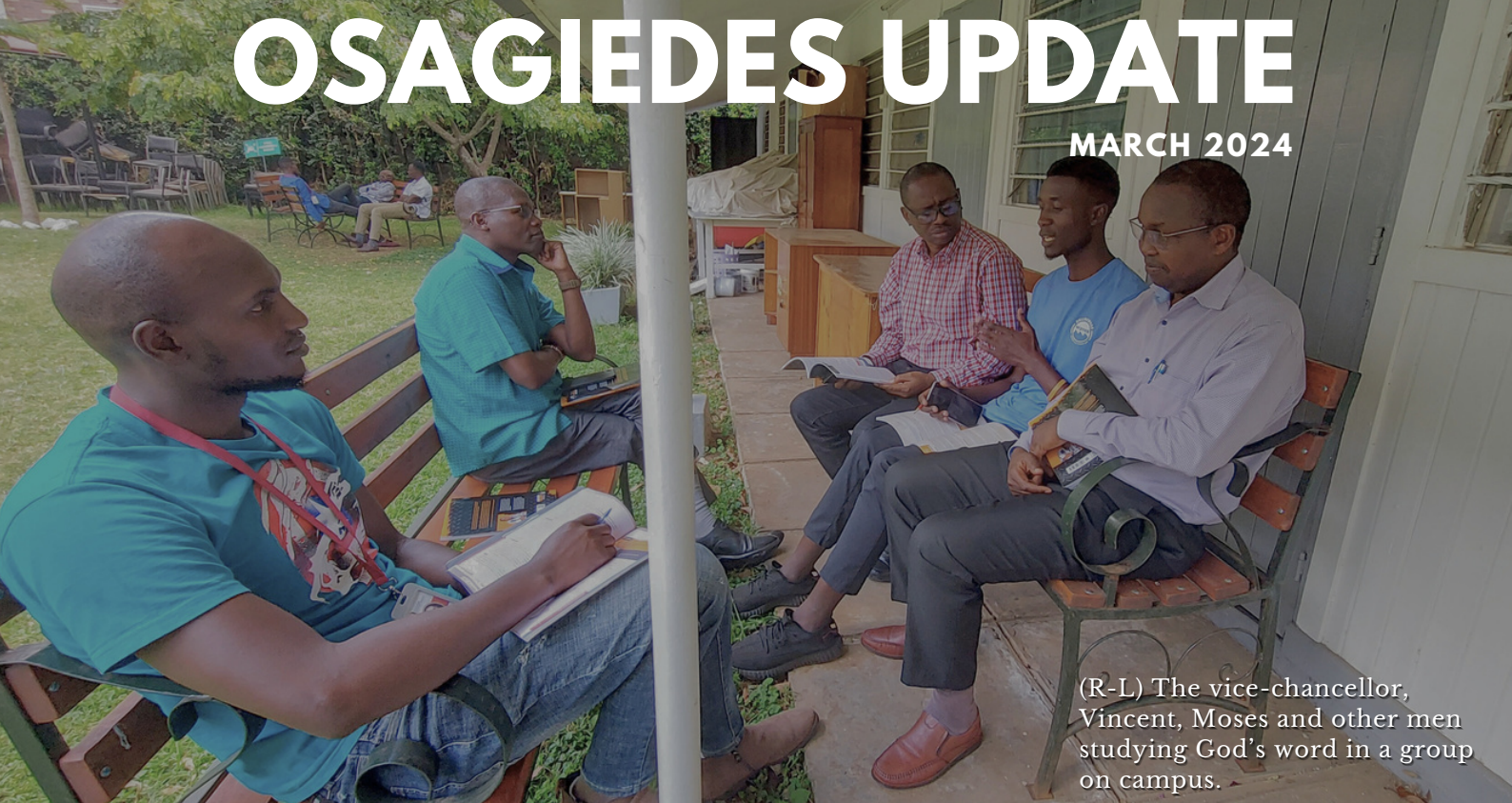

## ARE YOU MAN ENOUGH?

"In my 25 years of working here, this is the first time I have experienced something like this." This was the comment from a university staff member at the launch of our discipleship and mentoring program for men.

I am are grateful that on our campus, our leaders initiated a Bible study for men. It is known as "Man Enough - Bible studies." It is an 8-week Bible study series designed to help men strengthen their relationship with God, understand their roles and responsibilities in family and society. The group aims to hold men accountable to each other and provide opportunities for mentoring and coaching. All male staff on the campus were invited, and 19 men, including the vice chancellor and his two deputies, showed up. These university leaders are God-fearing men who are passionate about the transformation of our campus and the nation of Kenya.

We have completed 4 lessons of this exciting study, and it has been particularly impactful for me and the other men. We have gained valuable insights on deepening our faith, navigating the world of men, and reaching out to other men both on and off campus.

Learning from our elders, peers, and younger men has been a great privilege. I am learning five important lessons that a real man takes initiative, lives responsibly, leads sacrificially, loves faithfully, and leaves a worthy legacy. The question we ask each other is: "Are you man enough to live up to God's standard for men?"
