OSAGIEDES UPDATE

The day of the mission trip finally arrived, and everyone was filled with anticipation, the students, staff, and missionaries. Cinci and three of the ladies she discipled were part of that team of 38 at the 2024 Community Outreach to Ulauli, located in Marsabit County. The Ariel Community (Ulauli people), which has roots in the Samburu and Rendile tribes of Northern Kenya, reside there. The community lacks basic amenities, and a missionary organization runs a school and evangelizes amongst the people.

Despite the daunting challenges of flooding and multiple instances of the bus getting stuck, the

As the team arrived and settled down, they discovered that the Ulauli people were willing to listen to the team and offered a good reception. The community was conscious of God's existence and testified of the influence of the church on them, led by Pastor O, our host, and his counterpart Pastor P. Many of them acknowledged attending the church at the Ulauli Mission Centre.

The team's impact on the community was profound. They shared the Gospel through personal conversations and the Jesus film,

leading to salvation and healing. They also engaged with and taught children, youth, women, and leaders in this marginalized community, providing the much needed encouragement.

Seven people gave their lives to Christ after the team reached out to 165 people in this sparsely populated settlement. As a ministry, we believe in the importance of a long-term missionary presence, and the school where we serve (International Leadership University) has offered to support the missionary on the ground with Theological Education.

Our missionaries also took the opportunity to spend informal time with the students, encouraging them to consider being missionaries in whatever platform God places them. This interaction fostered a deeper understanding of the student's aspirations and planted seeds for their future work in the wider world.
